Your child has shown an interest in being a part of Smithville High School FFA Trap Shooting Team. Included in the list of documents are the known dates for the Area I FFA Trap League, Shooting Procedures, Parental Permission/ Release form, and a Student Information Form. Students who wish to participate **MUST have the "Parent Consent for Trap Shooting" and the "Shooting Code of Conduct"** signed and returned to Mr. Viebrock prior to participating in any event. New students to the sport must meet with Mr. Viebrock to learn the safety rules and procedures, and ensure that the event remains safe for all parties involved.

As an important side note, I have earned Level 1 Shotgun Coaching Certification through NRA, ATA, and the USA Shooting Sports Association. In addition, I have been certified as a Firearms Hunter Education and Bow Hunter Education Instructor through the Missouri Department of Conservation. I am Certified in First Aid and CPR with the American Red Cross. However, I am always welcome to new techniques used to enhance my training ability. I do not know everything, but I have had several hours of advanced training and I love working with young shooters.
